

Connecting Students in Rural India



This International Youth Day, the United Nations has designated the theme, "From Clicks to Progress: Youth Digital Pathways for Sustainable Development." At Share & Care, we understand the incredible effect that digital education has on students, especially in those from rural and poor backgrounds in India.

Since 2022, we have partnered with the Y4D Foundation Maharashtra to establish 11 Digital Training and Resource Centers (DTRC) across Maharashtra, Gujarat, and Uttar Pradesh. Previously, students learned on chalkboards, but now, each lab is equipped with a smartboard to enhance their learning. Additionally, we've provided 220 computers, essential furniture, and digital trainers for the teachers, ensuring effective use of the labs.
